MSU Union: The MSU Union, located at the corner of Abbott Road and Grand River in North Neighborhood, is home to many great student resources including the University Activities Board, Mosaic: The Multicultural Unity Center, the North Neighborhood Engagement Center, the Council of Progressive Student offices and plenty of studying space.

Office of Spartan Experiences: This office focuses on supporting over 1,000 registered student organizations, organizing fall welcome events, including Sparticipation and Convocation, and leadership development and recognition programs throughout the year.
